Internal Submission Deadline for <b>Concept Notes</b>	20 June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Submit Concept Note to Program Director (PD) by this date (some PDs may set earlier dates)</li> <li>• Minimum co-sponsors agreed by this deadline</li> <li>• Endorsement of Concept Notes commences</li> </ul>
Final Submission Deadline	8 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PDs submit endorsed Concept Notes to PMU by this date</li> <li>• Responsible APEC Fora assess eligibility and score Concept Notes</li> <li>• BMC makes final in-principle approvals</li> </ul>
Concept Note Selection Outcome	12 August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• POs receive advice of outcome</li> <li>• Successful POs commence preparation of their Project Proposal</li> </ul>
Submit <b>Project Proposal</b>	12 September	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must submit to Secretariat by this date</li> </ul>
BMC Approval of Project Proposals	October - December	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Final BMC approval (subject to forum endorsement and quality assessment by the Secretariat)</li> </ul>



# Promoting Project Quality in APEC – Tips for Forum Members

- Review Concept Notes carefully to ensure that the project **does**:
  - Have a clearly stated Objective and capacity building aims
  - Align with the forum’s Workplan
  - Align with APEC’s mandate and current strategies (esp. the Putrajaya Vision). Consider ‘why is APEC the best source of funds for the project’?
  - Identify a target group of beneficiaries to maximise capacity building impact and sustainability in participating APEC economies.
- Check that the project does **not**:
  - Duplicate previous project work undertaken in the forum (but projects may build on previous project outcomes to advance a stream of work towards longer term goals)
  - Have Intellectual Property implications or liability or reputational risks for APEC (e.g. no medical testing or procedures; no participation by individuals under 18 y.o.; no promotion of products or services; no investment facilitation; no industrial design, development or manufacturing of prototypes, systems, processes)
  - Have more than 3-4 outputs listed.



# Some points to note in project implementation

## ❖ Reviewing Process for APEC Publication

- Submit the draft publication (e.g. Final Report) 8 weeks before the Project Completion Date together with a Publication Request Form;
- PO to consult with APEC Publication Guidelines, including APEC Nomenclature (e.g. NOT to use “country”, “nation”, etc), before the submission to Secretariat;
- Submission by PO → Check by PD → Review by Publication Unit → Forum approval;

## ❖ Non Member Participants (NMP) List

- Submit 4 weeks before an event;  
if not possible, avoid a last-minute submission and secure sufficient time for forum approval;

## ❖ Project Completion Report (CR)

- Submit within 2 months after Project Completion;
- PO, not Contractor, is responsible for producing/submitting CR;
- Non-submission may affect all IEG members’ next Concept Note submission.
